



2019-2020 REFUGEE STUDENTS SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship supports select refugees, asylees, asylum seekers, and Special Immigrant Visa holders (SIVs) who are admitted incoming or continuing undergraduates at a University of California (UC) or California State University (Cal State) campus. The scholarship amount is **up to \$10,000** for an eligible UC student or **up to \$5,000** for an eligible Cal State student to be applied toward enrollment fees depending on individual financial need.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Refugee, asylee, asylum seeker or Special Immigrant Visa status
- Current or incoming UC or Cal State student
- Full-time enrollment
- Financial need
- Open to all majors
